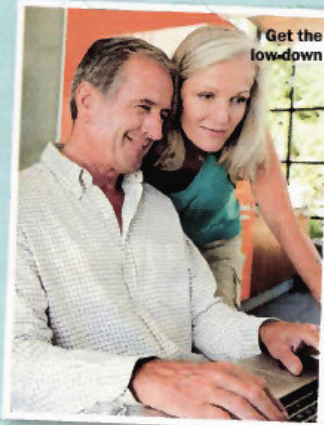

- 2 Lucky You?**
If you have a reliable car but just want peace of mind, it may be worth your while to consider a pay and claim policy. You pay a yearly fee and if and when you breakdown, you pay the costs and claim this back within 14 days.
- 3 All Round Cover To Suit You**

- 4 Always Check The Small Print**
Automatic services such as Green Flag, AA or RAC enable you to pay one yearly fee and you are covered for call outs. However, look at the small print, as some policies limit you to a certain number of call outs per year.
- 5 Get The Basics For Less**
If your car is less than five years old, it might be worth considering Green Insurance Breakdown Cover – policies start at only £18.45 for basic cover and £34 for full cover.
