Level 2 Award in 'Up Skilling' for Door Supervisors

On 6th March 2012 the Security Industry Authority (SIA) announced:



Following recommendations by the Security Industry Authority and in the interest of public safety, ministers have agreed that physical intervention skills training will become mandatory for all door supervisors in the United Kingdom.

The Security Industry Authority and Home Office have now stipulated that this change will occur as of February 2013.

As a result PROSEC will be delivering the Level 2 Award in 'Up Skilling' for Door Supervisors with immediate effect. The course covers the additional content now added to the Level 2 Award for Door Supervisors since it changed to the new QCF Qualification. This course predominantly covers 'Physical Intervention techniques', but also includes a 'Safety Awareness' module.

Our Physical Intervention trainers are National Federation for Personal Safety (NFPS) qualified, and the course is delivered following their guidelines. Because the course is structured and delivered by NFPS trainers, it is a 'practical, hands –on' course, unlike other physical intervention courses which are delivered purely using PowerPoint presentations.



Who is the course for?

As of 4th February 2013, ALL Door Supervisors who have completed their qualification, prior to the new QCF format (ie, didn't complete a Physical Intervention Module) will be required to have completed this 'Up-skilling Course' prior to renewing their current license.

As of this date the SIA **WILL NOT** renew any Door Supervisor license renewal applications without this qualification having been undertaken.

How long is the course?

This course is delivered over 1 Day and does require some student learning prior to the course (Normally 2 hours approx).

What does the course involve?

This new qualification will consist of 2 units:

Unit 1 • Physical Intervention Skills for the Private Security Industry – the same PI unit that is in the Door Supervision qualification including;

- The Law relating to the use of physical Intervention
- Implications of using Physical Intervention
- Good practise after using Physical Intervention
- Physical Intervention Techniques

Unit 2 · Safety Awareness for Door Supervisors – which will cover the following 3 subjects:

First Aid Awareness Counter Terrorism Dealing with children & young people

The Safety Awareness unit is effectively a distance learning unit which will take the form of a workbook which the candidate will complete in their own time prior to attending the course. The candidate will also take the assessment for the Safety Awareness unit on the day they attend the Up Skilling Course.



How is the course assessed?

The course is assessed using the following methods:

Unit 1 - Physical Intervention.

The physical intervention module is assessed using 3 methods:

- Continual observation throughout the day.
- Scenario based practical assessment using techniques taught.
- A true or false question paper with 10 questions. (10/10 pass mark)

Unit 2 - Safety Awareness.

The Safety Awareness module is assessed by a 10 question multiple choice paper with a pass mark of 7/10.

Are there any entry requirements?

To attend this course a candidate must already hold, and be able to produce a valid Door Supervisors SIA License. (Or one that has not expired longer than 3 years ago)

You will also be required to be Physically fit to attend the course and will be required to sign a medical declaration to state you are fit enough to attend. You do not have to be at 'Olympic Standard' of fitness and this is purely to declare any injuries which may preclude you from attending. You are also required to have basic level of English literacy, language and numeracy

How much will this course cost?

Course costs are likely to be £50.00 (+VAT), this will include examination and certification fees.
