DISCOVER HOW IT FEELS TO BE A SINGER/PERFORMER

An Introductory one day course planned to take place December / January 9.30 - 4.30
with tea, coffee and refreshments

Venue: Sark Chapel, Hethersgill, Carlisle, Cumbria
situated close to the Roman Wall and The Borders

Learn the skills of wakening up the voice unique only to you and watch how any singing issues you may have begin to disappear. The tutor will explain what this wonderful technique known as bel canto (beautiful singing) has to offer; the only technique trusted by all the great singers since 17th century. It is suggested you bring along items e.g. a notebook, recorder, perhaps a backing track as there will be opportunities to sing a piece in front of the other students (note there is no obligation to sing solo). There will be general discussions e.g. why we like to sing, time for questions, vocal warmups, speaking on the resonance, improvisation and choir work.



This course offers the very rare opportunity to begin to learn a little about this dying art which desperately needs to be kept 'alive'. It is equally beneficial for the popular singer as for the classical singer. All ages are welcome; the curious, the novice, those who would like to sing but who have never had the opportunity, even those who are not confident, and those who already enjoy singing on the platform. A perfect course to cheer up everyone during the winter months held in a warm, homely, and friendly environment. The chapel is spacious with central heating throughout and also has a log fire, a new kitchen and two sitting rooms. In recent years the chapel has been used for art exhibitions, art workshops, concerts and is regularly let out to holidaymakers.
