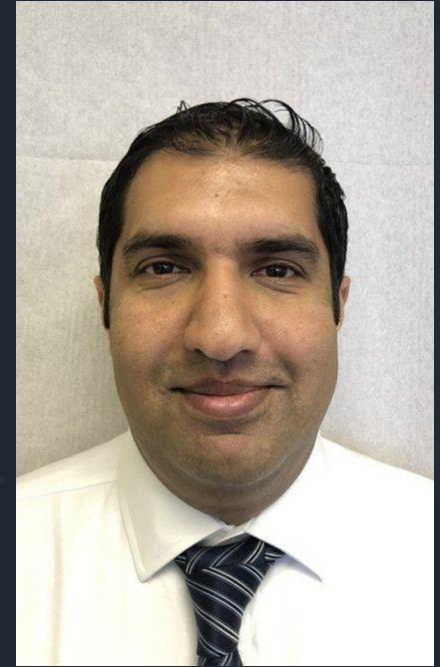

# 'High Dependency' Ambulance Service

- Crews Led by Ambulance Technician or HCPC Paramedic, Working with an Emergency Driver, allowing for a greater range of clinical monitoring and interventions.
- Designed for Individuals requiring additional support, monitoring or basic clinical interventions during the transport.
- Ideal Crew Level for Inter-Facility Transfers and Long Distance Repatriation where there is a possibility of the patients condition changing whilst en route.
- Available to NHS and Private Clients as dictated by the needs of the patient or the contract.
- Available for Ad-Hoc single journeys, or for longer term, regular commitments.





# ICU, Neonatal, Critical Care and 999 Support.

- Codeblue's Ambulance Vehicles are equipped to a standard matching (and in some cases exceeding the NHS Standard for 999 Emergency Work), which makes us an ideal candidate for ICU, Critical Care and Neonatal Transfer Work.
